

Short Bio Prof. Juergen Wasem

Juergen Wasem studied economics and political science at the University of Cologne (Germany), Pennsylvania State University (USA) and University of Sussex (UK); MA in economics in Cologne; PhD in economics, Cologne; PhD (habilitation) in public health, Bielefeld.

He is director and professor of the Institute for Health Care Services Management and Research at the University Duisburg-Essen (since 2003). Former positions were: professor and chair of the Institute of Health Care Management at the Ernst Moritz Arndt-University Greifswald, professor for health economics at the school of public health at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich, professor for health insurance at the institute for insurance business at the University for Applied Sciences Cologne. Before his academic career he has worked in the department for health insurance in the German Ministry of Health.

Juergen Wasem is President Past of the German Health Economics Association (dggoe), member of Board of Directors of Federal Association for Managed Care (BMC), Chair of Academic Advisory Board for the Further Development of Risk Adjustment at the Federal Insurance Office, Chairman of the Federal Arbitration Committee between Social Health Insurance Funds and the Federal Association of Self Employed Physicians (EBA), Chair of the Arbitration Committee between Social Health Insurance Funds and pharmaceutical companies concerning prices of new patented drugs; Chair of the Arbitration Committee between Social Health Insurance and Pharmaceutical Companies on Prices of new drugs; Board of GVG and of various policy advisory boards. He has been member of the Scientific Committee of the International Health Economics Association IHEA.
